Incidents like this raise many questions, including the question: 'Where is God in the midst of all this?' At moments like this I am reminded of something I read many years ago and which has remained with me:

'In Jesus, God did not come to explain suffering, or to remove it, but to fill it with his presence.'

In this life we may not get all the answers we seek to the pain and problem of suffering. We live in a world which continues to be torn apart by suffering in many ways. But I believe we live in a world which is held and shaped by the love and light of God. Jesus came to fill the world with his presence.
